















Protected Characteristics; Story Book Spine

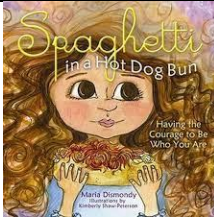
It is important that all pupils gain an understanding of the world they are growing up in and learn how to live alongside and show respect for a diverse range of people.
