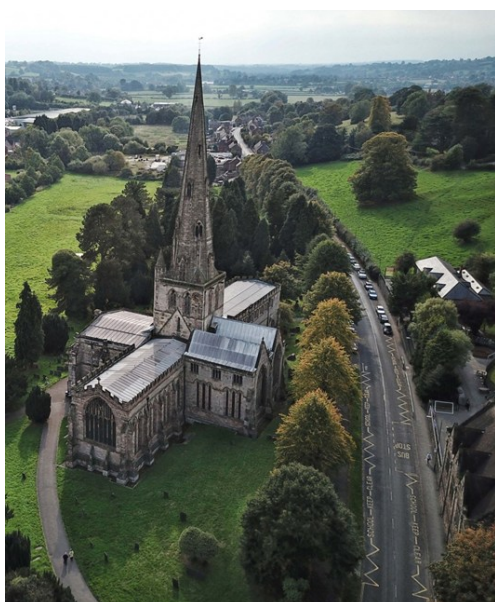


CHORUS
